

This is My Neighbourhood

Woodcreek Community Association has been selected as a participant in the City of Calgary's *This is My Neighbourhood* (TIMN) program.

TIMN began in 2015 with a group of 14 inaugural communities. As part of the TIMN program, the City partnered with a group of neighbourhoods in Round 1 to deliver more than 100 programs, services and small scale improvement projects that residents requested. Woodcreek was chosen by City Counsellors as one of 14 communities for Round 2.

The program is multi-stage and starts with:

1. Establishing an ad hoc committee to provide feedback on initiatives that would make our Community even better
2. Talking to our Community at the many events hosted by Woodcreek Community Association to gather your feedback between March and July.
3. Responding to a questionnaire from the City which will be mailed out sometime in March.
4. Establishing a vision of what might be possible.

Once the feedback stage is completed, the next step involves identifying specific initiatives that the City might help us with on 2018.
